RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Permit given when completed registration application is approved. The parking permit is transferable to another registered vehicle that you plan to drive to school
2. The permit **MUST** be displayed (printed facing out) in the back window (left side) when vehicle is on school property.
3. Obey traffic directions of any teacher, safety patrol, or administrator – **BE COURTEOUS** at all times.
4. **OBEY SPEED LIMITS OF 5 MPH.** "Jack-rabbit" starts, spinning of wheels or any other form of reckless and dangerous driving will be considered a "moving violation".
5. **OBEY ALL SIGNS AND PRINTED PAVEMENT RESTRICTIONS.** Parking must be proper in assigned area. Improper parking will be considered a "non-moving violation".
6. There is no unauthorized driving on campus, congregating or loitering on parking lot or in cars during the school day. When students arrive at school, they are to immediately properly park and lock their vehicle, then move to their classroom area. No student is to return to a vehicle at any time during the school day for any reason including lunch period without authorization from the office. This will be considered a "non-moving violation".
7. Student passengers of a student driver, other than immediate family members, **MUST** have written parental permission on file in the principal's office.
8. Violations of the above, at the principal's discretion, will be cause for revoking the student driver's driving privilege:
 - a. Non-moving – a 20 school day suspension of driving privileges. This will include driving an unregistered vehicle after the Friday deadline.
 - b. Moving – a 45 school day suspension of driving privileges. This will occur for a second "non-moving violation".
