

G.O.W.N. REQUIREMENTS

2007 – 2008

ALL STUDENTS ENROLLED IN ANY BIBLE COURSE

7th – 12th grades

1. All projects must have prior approval from your Bible teacher. Summer projects must be approved by the student's Bible teacher from the previous school year.
2. All projects must be completed, with all paperwork turned in to your Bible teacher, by May 16, 2008.
3. Your Christian Service project must address a documented need.
4. You may receive no compensation for your service project.
5. You must be able to integrate the Christian Worldview into your service project.
6. You must help someone, other than a relative, who has a physical or spiritual need, which would not have otherwise been met.
7. You must submit the signed permission form to secure prior approval for your project.
8. A one-page log must be submitted which indicates the exact times and dates you devoted to this project. **A 30 minimum is required to receive credit for this project for 9th – 12th grade students. 7th & 8th grade students are required to dedicate 15 hours to this project.**
9. You must submit with your log, a statement on company or agency letterhead, which includes the address, phone number, and the name of the contact person who supervised your project. Please have your project supervisor write a short letter evaluating your effectiveness with your G.O.W.N. project. This letter can be written on the same sheet of letterhead, which includes the other required information.
10. The final requirement of your Christian Service Project is to write a one page (typed) essay of reflection and celebration about your G.O.W.N. project. You may include pictures, scripture which is relevant to this project, songs, poems, and/or artwork.

Your essay should address the following questions:

- a. What biblical basis did you use when choosing this project?
- b. Compare and contrast the people whom you were serving with the Christian young people in your school.
- c. What is the lasting impact of this project on your Christian development?
- d. What is an appropriate way to celebrate the completion of this project?
- e. Do you plan to continue or enhance the Christian service you have provided to others who have a physical and/or spiritual need?

**Please remember that all of the components of your Christian Service Project are due to your Bible teacher on or before May 16, 2008.
