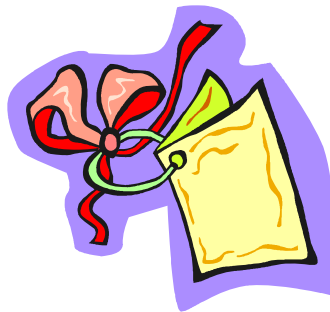

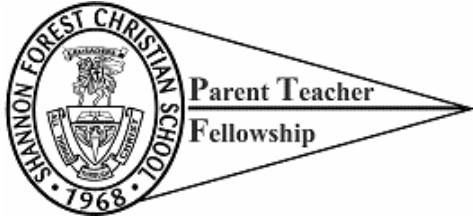
If a student is staying for the full school day, please send a sleeping mat or blanket for their use. Students with frequent extensions should purchase the mat, pillow, and pillow case.

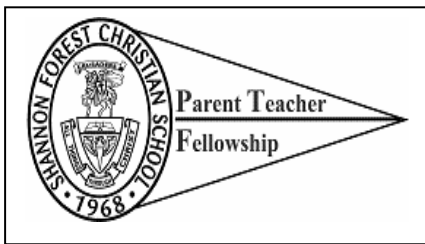
